This is a part-time course for people who want to become Kindergarten teachers, for those who have an interest in Anthroposophy and for individuals who are interested in personal growth and creative development.

The course is designed as an autonomous introduction to Anthroposophy (knowledge of the human being) and as a foundation to a further two-year Fetac accredited course in Steiner Waldorf Childcare.

Progression to second year is dependent on successful completion of the Orientation Course or its equivalent

Foundation Year

This course will serve as a foundation for pedagogical and other studies in the field of Anthroposophy. The skills learnt on this course will be of benefit to all and will enhance ones' quality of life. We will look at life in many new and unusual ways, with a core focus on discovery, self-development and creative engagement in:



The curriculum has an experiential focus and is embedded in the cycle of the year. A Prerequisite for participation is interest and curiosity as well as the willingness to gain new concepts and a keenness to find answers for personal growth.

The course setting is near the village of Grangemockler, Co. Tipperary, at the foot of Slievnamon close to the Comeragh Mountains, an area rich in nature and spiritual history.

The modules contain elements of:

Discovery: the cycle of the year with experiential exercises based on observations and celebrating seasonal festivals.

Creativity: painting, form drawing, sculpting, poetry, story telling, music and Eurythmy, working with wool, singing, games.

Learning: the contents of spiritual science i.e. the development of the world, the path of knowledge, the evolution of consciousness.

Self-development: meditation, perception-exercises, and reflection.

Course Fees

The complete fee for the Orientation Year is €1,500.00

A deposit of €200.00 is required with your application

The remaining fees can be paid either in full or in installments.

Accommodation

The course takes place in Camphill, Grangemockler, Co.Tipperary between Clonmel and Kilkenny. There is a range of options for accommodation in the immediate area, in the village of Grangemockler or in and around the towns of Callan and Carrick-on-Suir.
